After 20 fulfilling years in the Air Force working in radiology and ultrasound, I relocated to Washington State to support my son, who's deployed aboard the USS Nimitz. Looking for a healthier way to manage stress and anxiety, I joined Project Healing Waters after a fellow veteran recommended it.

TIPPET TIPS

Applying a little water or saliva to lubricate the **tippet** before setting a knot will minimize the chance of weakening tippet and losing flies and fish.



Use your nippers to cut **tippet** at an angle. This ensures a finer point which maximizes your success in threading the eye of flies.



Label your **tippet** with the purchase date. While tippet doesn't have an expiration date, it can weaken with age and exposure to UV so it helps you keep track of your freshest tippet.



EDUCATION

TIPPET

Tippet is a critical part of your fly rigging and is used for tasks like prolonging leaders and rigging additional flies.

Many types of tippet are available:

- **Monofilament** versatile and the most affordable of tippets. It floats well and is the go-to for dry fly fishing.
- **Fluorocarbon** doesn't transmit light underwater, is more pliable, and is more resilient against cuts and nicks from rocks. For these reasons, it is best when nymphing or streamers.
- **Specialized Tippets** you may see sighter, wire, or other unique tippets intended for specialized fishing techniques and species.

Tippet ranges in size 0x to 7x, strongest to weakest, and with strength comes larger diameter. It's important to select a tippet size small enough to not spook the fish, while also strong enough to ensure you can land them quickly.

Another good rule of thumb in selecting tippet is that it shouldn't be stronger than your leader.

When trout fishing in the PNW, I find I mostly use 3x-5x tippet, and only occasionally need to move to 6x. I usually begin my day with 4x, but will vary depending on technique and river conditions.
